Welcome to the NSW Roadmap competitive tender process for **Tender Round 9 - Long Duration Storage (LDS) Infrastructure** conducted by AusEnergy Services Limited (**ASL**) as the NSW Consumer Trustee. Registration is now open.

This tender process is designed to select quality Projects capable of delivering electricity infrastructure that is in the long-term financial interests of NSW electricity customers.

There are two sequential steps to initiate your participation in this Tender Round. The first step is to register your Project (through this Registration Form) and the second step is to submit a Bid (through a separate **Bid Form**). Additionally, the Consumer Trustee will operate a limited Q&A (in accordance with section 3.1.1 of the Tender Guidelines) to facilitate the Tender Round, commencing on Wednesday, 20 May 2026.

The product available in Tender Round 9 is the **LDS LTESA**. The LDS LTESA is a financial derivative contract between an LTES Operator and the Scheme Financial Vehicle (**SFV**) that provides an LTES Operator with a series of options to access a variable annuity payment in the form of a top up to net operational revenues achieved by the Project, increasing project cash-flow and reducing cash-flow volatility. The Project types permitted to bid for an LDS LTESA are:

- **LDS only** - Standalone storage asset with no co-located generation asset.
- **Non-Assessed Hybrid** - An LDS storage asset and a co-located generation asset. Only the LDS storage asset is assessed and contractually required for delivery. As a Non-Assessed Hybrid, you may also bid your generation asset into the Consumer Trustee's concurrent Tender Round 8 - Generation Infrastructure as a Non-Assessed Hybrid.

Please note, for the LDS LTESA the LTES Operator must maintain the Project's storage duration **at or above 8 hours throughout the term of the LTESA, based on the ratio of storage capacity (in MWh) to Contracted Export Capacity (in MW)**.

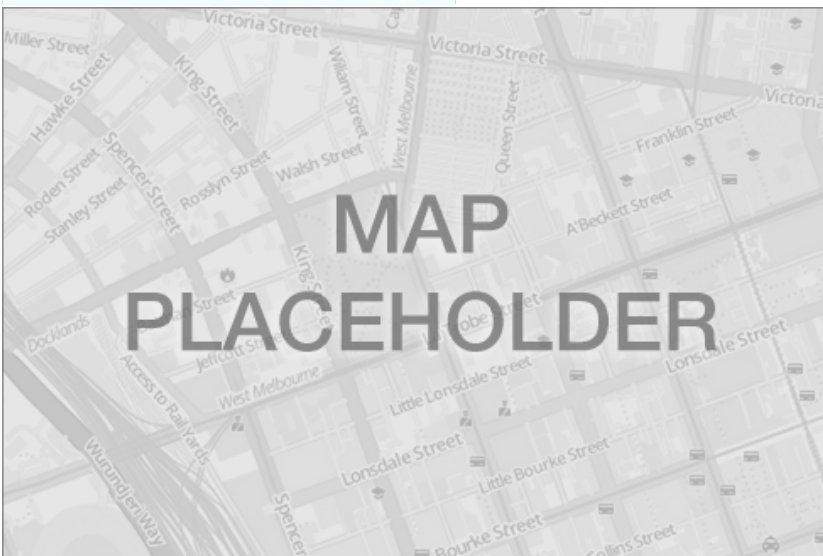

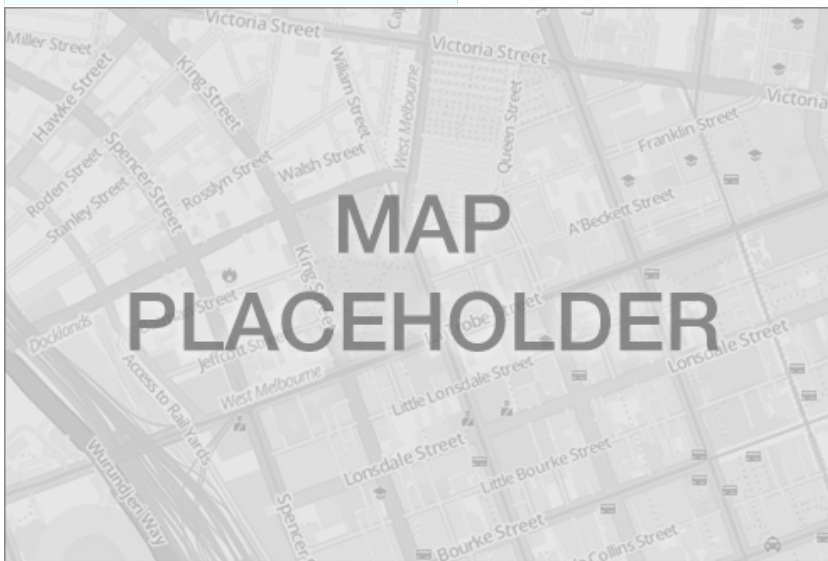
